Wet areas like bathrooms and kitchens tend to get limescale so you need to wash this using a limescale remover.

There are many limescale removers for example, Viakal, Cillit Bang etc .

You need to pay particular attention around sink taps, plug holes, mirrors, shower glass doors

Dusting round items leaves islands of dust.

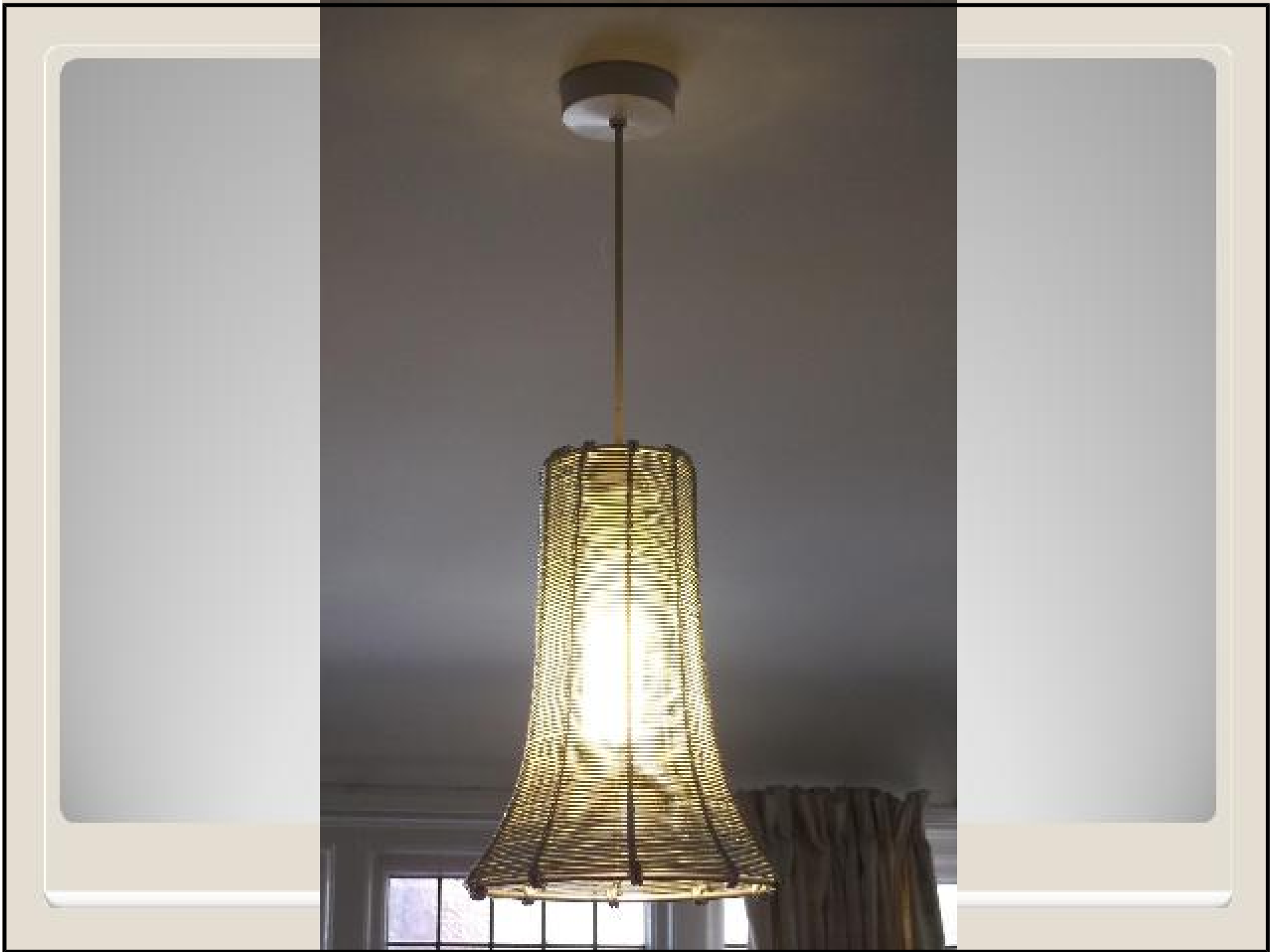








You should pay attention to cobwebs,
particularly on lamp shades, in corners,
behind doors and behind radiators.















In many houses you will get bathrooms with glass shower doors as below.

These doors tend to limescale mainly inside as this is the main area that gets wet.

You will need to wash this off with a limescale remover and sponge.

After washing, you need to rinse off and then dry off with a dry cloth.

You can finish off with a glass cleaner to give the glass a streak free finish. Remember please dont leave streaky surfaces.



You will find different types of vacuum cleaners. Please familiarise yourself with these.

You can go on Google, if unsure please ask the client but you need also to do your homework and make sure that you know the basics.

Some vacuum cleaners are bagless, and some have bags. Either way, you need to make sure that you empty the vacuum cleaners regularly. If a vacuum cleaner is not working, most likely it is because it's full or blocked.



There are different types of limescale removers.

As with all chemicals you need to READ the label and know how to use it and what surfaces to use it for.

Many damages are caused by incorrect use of chemicals, so be extremely careful with product use.

Examples of limescale removers are Cillit Bang or Viakal



- **How to stand out from other cleaners?**

When vacuuming also do edges, corners and clean BEHIND doors

Ensure that all sinks, surfaces, taps, glass/mirrors are streak free. No smears!!

Move things when you dust, dont dust around items or furniture.

Tidy up and neaten when you clean, organising items according to size.

Fold clothes on beds and tidy up.

Clear the kitchen sink

Dust skirting boards, tops of pictures.

Use initiative and just see what else needs doing.
